

Safe Rider Shuttle

Lost track of time while studying late at Hillman and don't feel comfortable walking back to South Oakland? Your club meeting in North Oakland runs late and you need a ride back to Towers? SafeRider is only a tap away!

SafeRider is a secure, reliable way to get to your residence when you are not on an established bus or shuttle route. This complimentary transportation service is available for non-emergencies daily from 9 p.m. to 3 a.m. for locations between Baum Boulevard on the north, Carnegie Mellon University on the east, the Center for Biotechnology and Bioengineering on the south, and Trees Hall/Robinson Street on the west.

SafeRider is available for Pitt students, staff, and faculty who can bring along up to two non-University guests. Each rider is permitted one round-trip per evening, with a maximum of 25 trips per semester. You must show your Panther Card for service.



The TransLoc app is the recommended way to request a ride. You can also call SafeRider at 412-648-CALL (2255).

Routes

Use SafeRider when traveling between campus buildings, from local residences to campus buildings, and from campus to local residences that aren't along Pitt shuttle or PRT bus routes.

If your origin and destination aren't on a Pitt shuttle or PRT bus route, SafeRider provides point-to-point service.

If your origin isn't on a Pitt shuttle or PRT bus route but your destination is, SafeRider will take you to the shuttle stop located at the Cathedral of Learning so that you can safely continue to your destination from there.

Please note: If your origin is on a Pitt shuttle or PRT bus route during active hours, you must use those services. SafeRider is a supplement to those transportation options.



Set up your account today!

1. Download the TransLoc app (transloc.com/app)
2. Go to settings
3. Log in with your University account
4. Select University of Pittsburgh
5. Log in to Pitt Passport with your Pitt credentials
6. Enter your information: username, Pitt email, first name, last name, and phone number
7. Create account
8. Use the TransLoc app to request SafeRider using the OnDemand tab at the bottom
